Description: MAC Ski and Snowboard is searching for experienced ski and snowboard coaches for its Freeride Team programs. Assistant Coaches work Holiday Camp, December 27-30, and 1-2 weekend days per week from January through March, and report directly to the Lead Freeride Team Coach, and Program Director/Head Coach.

The MAC Freeride Team is an all-mountain ski and snowboard team, teaching aspiring athletes the skills of all-terrain skiing and riding, backcountry safety and etiquette, avalanche awareness, ski-mountaineering fundamentals, and skill development for Skier-X, Half-Pipe, and Slopestyle competition. Our program is beginning to take off, sending 4 athletes to USASA Freeride Nationals at Copper Mountain in 2022. As we take the Freeride Team to the next level, we need motivated coaches that fit our positive team culture and share in our mountain passion and zest for teaching youth skills and life lessons through snow sport.

MAC Ski and Snowboard is a Certified US Ski and Snowboard Club, serving the members of the Multnomah Athletic Club at the highest level in multiple winter sports.

Qualifications: Level 1 PSIA or Level 100 US Ski & Snowboard/USASA Certification preferred. 2 years competing/coaching/instruction experience required and meets all US Ski & Snowboard Coaching requirements (Background Screen, SafeSport Training, Avalanche Training, Concussion Training, CPR/First Aid Training, Coaching Fundamentals Course). Additional certifications/education through AIARE (American Institute for Avalanche Research and Education) are encouraged. Competitive team coaching experience preferred, but not required. Working knowledge of various athletic activities and facilities. Demonstrated effective planning and organizational skills. Demonstrated technological proficiency including a working knowledge of computer applications and smart phone applications (i.e., email communication, Microsoft Office programs, use of Dayforce App for employee self-management, and use of Team Snap App for scheduling and communication to athletes and parents).

Pay/Benefits: The Assistant Ski/Snowboard Coach position has a starting hourly rate of \$21/hour. Coaching wage may increase based upon candidate's experience and professional certifications. Coaches earn a free season pass to Mt.
