<u>Site</u>: Mt. Bachelor Ski Resort, Cliffhanger (SG and GS) Thunderbird (SL) <u>Headquarters</u>: Junior Race Center and Lower West Village Lodge (SL day)

<u>Eligibility</u>: USSS Scored Race, Open to licensed USSS Members U16 and older. **Selected U14s will be eligible after points are tallied at the U14 Finals, April 1st. A Divisional Ski Up Agreement will be required prior to race day. PLEASE NOTE: The Ski Up Agreement requires athlete signature, parent signature AND coaches signature.**

<u>Deadline</u>: Registration CLOSES on Monday, April 15, at 10:00 pm PDT. No late entries will be accepted. Competitors must hold a <u>CURRENT</u> USSS Competitor's License. Please

update your license prior to registering for this race.

Tickets:

- Racer tickets are \$62/day and can be purchased using the following link. RACER
 TICKETS ARE ONLY FOR RACERS AND COACHES AND CANNOT BE PURCHASED BY
 FAMILIES. THE START LIST WILL BE USED TO VERIFY PURCHASES.

- <u>PARENTS</u> will need to buy the racer tickets for their children, online and in advance. This will ensure that they complete the mandatory One Resort waiver. <u>Coaches or clubs cannot purchase passes on the children's behalf.</u>
- One coaches' ticket per 10 athletes.
- Pick-Up Process: Tickets can be picked up using the barcode on the confirmation email from the ticket purchase. You can scan and print a pass from one of the Mt. Bachelor Pick-Up Kiosks located in Bend (Bend Park N' Ride lot on Columbia or the Sun Country Tours Office and at the Resort (Sunrise and West Village Base Areas). We cannot emphasize enough the importance of purchasing tickets and getting passes before you come to the mountain. This will streamline your race morning and reduce stress for everyone! You cannot pick up tickets at the JRC/Race Headquarters on race mornings.
- Elite Passes will be honored. Elite Pass holders will be sent a voucher.

Liability: 2 liability waivers are required.

- MBSEF Waiver included in registration. Must be completed.
- Mt. Bachelor Waiver included in ticket purchase. Must be completed.

Bib Deposit: None required; a \$50 fee will be charged for any lost bibs!

<u>Bib Distribution</u>: Bibs will be distributed each morning to the coaches in the JRC (SG and GS races) and the Lower West Village Lodge (SL race)

Awards: Awards presented after GS1 race for SG and GS1. Next set of awards will be presented after GS2 and SL race. Awards will be given to top 3 U14s for each gender and the top 5 Overall for each gender. Move-Up awards will be presented for each race.

Notice Board: WhatsApp will be used in lieu of a Notice Board for Ref Reports, Schedule, etc. Live Timing will also be a means of communication.
