NCC Motions since spring 2024 board meeting:

June 19, 2024 Meeting

1. To use 4 of 8 races for Jr. National qualification, with an athlete required to attend 4 race days to be eligible for selection to the team.

NB: in re-writing the rule book I noticed that a potential oversight of the rule in case of race cancellations, Reitler (who proposed the original motion) stated that his intention was to have an athlete attend a minimum of 50% of the races so the section which covers the contingency qualifying procedures when less than 8 races are held, was changed with language to reflect 50% instead of 4 races minimum.

Fall meeting:

- 1. Named Mike Burns as rep to US Officials Subcommittee
- Agreed with Far West division to alternate the Pacific representation on the USSS XC Sport Committee and Coaches Subcommittee so that each division always has one active representative on each committee.
- 3. Named Reitler Hodgert to USSS Junior subcommittee (unofficial committee below coaches committee)
- 4. Named Pete Leonard to Sport Committee/Coach Subcommittee spot for USSS.
- 5. Allow PNW clubs to use PNW wax box at Sr. Nationals and Open Races, paying a \$50 fee per athlete per race. (a typical junior nationals race costs \$33/athlete).
 - Allows recycling of wax inventory more readily.
- Wax takes up a specific portion of the budget, reduces duplication of resources, should in theory save quite a lot of money for PNW skiers.
- Example Scenario: X number of people going to Sr. Nationals, X number of races, X number using the open wax boxes leads to per person calculation of waxing cost.
 - Paid to PNW similar to head tax for JNQs. Money gets earmarked for JNs wax box.
 - 6. Remove language from Comp Guide requiring PNW skiers from having a PNW uniform, allowing athletes to use their own uniform.
 - a. Presents a potential \$300 savings
 - b. Clubs will continue to try to find old uniforms for skiers looking for one
