11:00 AM: Awards- or 20 minutes after last racer finishes.

Lollipop Race:

11:30 AM: U14 and younger 2.5km mass start.

Trail Passes:

Racers: Trail passes will be included with race registration. Racers will NOT need to buy a trail pass at the Nordic Lodge. Racers will get their trail pass from their coach or at the Nordic Lodge (pre-ready).

Spectators: Mt. Bachelor requires a trail pass for anyone who is not already a season pass holder. A Mt. Bachelor Nordic Center trail pass can be purchased at the Nordic Lodge. Or online at <https://www.mtbachelor.com/the-mountain/nordic/tickets-passes>

Coaches: USSS Licensed Coaches who have a coaching bib will receive a trail pass for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. These can be picked up at the Nordic Lodge window on Friday.

*All racers, spectators and volunteers must be on skis on the trail network with the exception of the team tent area next to the stadium, and volunteers working stadium jobs. Walking on the trails is not allowed. Snowshoe access to the racecourse is possible but requires a trail pass.

Registration:

- There is no Day-of-Race registration.
- Athletes racing USSS (scored) age 14+, NRL Race
- Athletes racing age (6-13 non scored), Lollipop Race
- Bib pick up for teams and individuals will be distributed at the TCM Friday evening.
- Unpicked up bibs will be at the Start Area from 8:00 both days.

- Racers will keep their bibs after the Saturday race and use the same bibs on Sunday. Bibs will be collected after the Sunday race.
- Racers only racing Saturday should turn in their race bibs at the finish Saturday.

Start List:

The start lists will be posted Friday after the coaches meeting online at [webscorer](#). The posted start list will represent any changes made at the coaches meeting to the seeding, group order, etc. Coaches are responsible for ensuring their athletes details are corrected at Friday night's race meeting. Any start list posted or circulated prior to that will be considered Drafts.

Results:

Unofficial results will be posted at [Webscorer.com](#). Results will be posted and updated periodically through the day. Protests are usually due within 15 minutes after completion of races; thereafter results will usually be finalized by Jury.

Awards:

Awards to the top 3 finishers in each NRL scored age group will be given at the conclusion of the race at the venue. (See schedule.)

Course Inspection:

Courses will be signed Friday AM. Beware of two-way skiing as the race courses are open to all skiing Friday, and the Saturday and Sunday courses share sections of trail but running in opposite directions.

Registration

Please Note! There are four steps to have registration complete (how to do each step is below). Please follow the instructions below to complete all four steps. (This is our plea... please do all four so we don't have to hunt you down by emailing you regarding missing steps. Thank you in advance!)

1. Have a current USSS license (*Cross Country Competitor* license if wanting NRL points)
2. Register racer(s) on [Webscorer.com](#)
3. Fill out the MBSEF waiver (see link below) AND scan completed waiver and email to **nordicrace@mbsef.org**.
4. Fill out the Mt Bachelor waiver (see link below) AND screenshot it and email to **nordicrace@mbsef.org**.

Step 1: USSS License:

Any level US Ski and Snowboard (USSS) member can race in the US Ski and Snowboard race. A **Cross Country Competitor** membership is needed to earn National Ranking List points and is a must if you are looking to qualify for the Junior National Championships in March. Also, please make sure you have a current USSS license (U18+ MUST have their background check and SafeSport complete for their license to be **current!** Racers cannot race unless their license is current.)

New Members- Create an account at [my.us Skiandsnowboard.org](https://www.us Skiandsnowboard.org). Please choose **Cross Country Competitor** as the license if you want points for the National Ranking List (NRL).

Step 2: Race Registration:

Registration Closes at 11:59 PM on **Tuesday, December 10th**. Late registration will be \$20/race, available until Dec 12th at 8 pm.

Waxing Restrictions and Recommendations

Per PNSA rules all skiers agree to use a non-fluorinated glide wax which will be announced by the race organizer.

The glide wax for the race will be decided by 10AM 12/11/24 and communicated to participating clubs and individuals.

No fluorinated products are allowed in grip wax products (hard wax, klister, covers, etc.). For more information on the fluorocarbon ban – including a list of non-fluorinated kick waxes and klisters – visit the [US Skiing page](#) on the subject.

SPRINT FINAL Protocols:

Athletes will practice protocols to be employed at US Nationals & JNs but being required to:

A) ski on only one pair during the quarter, semi & finals

B) coaches cannot brush, re-wax, etc. Only minimal adjustment of kick zone wax is allowed.
