Lifts: Athlete tickets are \$60.00 + tax.

Mission Ridge has an online ticketing system and tickets must be purchased online in advance. Here are the steps:

- 1. **Before** Feb. 19: go to above link and purchase your ticket. If you do not have one, you will create an account, upload a photo and sign the online waiver. This will include the purchase of an RFID card that can be re-loaded for future tickets (not just this season). Replacement cards are \$5. We do not recommend trying to purchase online tickets in the parking lot as reception is not reliable. Tickets purchased at the ticket window will dramatically increase wait times please pre-purchase.
- 2. On Feb. 19 go to the ticket window and pick up your pre-paid pass. This card will work for future visits.

PNSA Elite Passes will be honored. You must create an account and upload your Elite pass **prior to the first day of the camp** for your pass to scan good at the lift. Waiting to show the pass at the window will slow the process down. Create an account and upload your Elite pass here: https://estore.missionridge.com/special-events/products/racer-elite-pass

Coach tickets: Coaches must be USSS registered coaches to receive a complimentary ticket. *Please register on the site listed above (same as athlete registration) to complete the waivers.*

Waivers: athlete waivers will be completed during the registration process.
