ENTRY FEE/ WAIVER	\$60.00 per race. All athletes and coaches must register and pay via www.AdminSkiRacing.com by March 29, 11:59pm. Coaches must be on athletes' green sheets.
RACER LIFT TICKETS	Adult \$85.00 (19yrs and up), \$70.00 Youth Lift Ticket (13yrs -18yrs), Child Ticket is \$43.00, and Parent ticket \$125.00. Once you register for the race the link for day of race tickets will be emailed to you. MUST PURCHASE TICKETS by April 2 at 11:59pm. If you have valid IKON pass you don't need to purchase lift ticket.
TICKET PICKUP	Athletes and parents pick up their pre-purchased tickets at the main ticketing window open at 7:30am on Race Days. No walk-up Lift Tickets can be purchased at the Window. Tickets can be printed out in the Kiosk in front of ticket office.
BIBS	Bib pickup by Team Coach at 7:30am morning of race at the Upstairs Competition Service Race Central Office. Bibs must be turned into bins at finish arena at the end of race. Missing bib fee is \$75.00.
