Entry Deadline:

Registration opens 30 days prior to event. Registration for entries closes January 2, 2026, 11:59 PM. Coaches and officials are required to register at adminskiracing.com Coaches must appear on Green Sheet to receive lift ticket.

Lift Tickets:

Athletes lift ticket: Adult (23-69) \$89.00, Young Adult (13-22) \$69.00. Discounted Parent tickets for athletes on the start list are \$109. Special ticket link to be sent prior to race day to all registered athletes and coaches.

Team Captains Meeting:

Bib required for all races and to be distributed to a Team Captain at morning of each race, <u>Main Lodge</u> 07:30 AM. Missing and unreturned bibs incur \$50 fee.
