ELIGIBILITY:	USSS membership required		
EQUIPMENT:	 Hard Ear Helmets bearing the FIS sticker 3.6 must be worn by all GS competitors. [Masters ICR art. MA 11) b)] Fluro-carbon waxes are banned from all USSS Sanctioned Races. All equipment must conform to the USSS Masters regulations. The competitor is responsible for the equipment that he/she uses. Equipment may be subject to inspection at start. Competitors in Masters events are recommended to compete on equipment designed for the particular event (DH, SL, GS, SG); there are no recommendations in regard to ski length, radius or profile width. Maximum stand height is 50 mm. Maximum boot height is 45 mm.

REGISTRATION:	Online only. All USS and Summit at Snoqualmie policies, procedures, and protocols will be followed by all involved.		
TC MEETING:	Daily TC at 9:00am - After Jury Inspection and prior to competitor inspection — Held at the start arena - Random Computer Draw within each class.
