MA 11) b)] • Fluro-carbon waxes are banned from all USSS Sanctioned Races. • All equipment must conform to the USSS Masters regulations. • The competitor is responsible for the equipment that he/she uses. Equipment may be subject to inspection at start. • Competitors in Masters events are recommended to compete on equipment designed for the particular event (DH, SL, GS, SG); there are no recommendations in regard to ski length, radius or profile width. Maximum stand height is 50 mm. Maximum boot height is 45 mm.
