Once you register for the race the link for day of race tickets will be emailed to you. Must purchase tickets by March 11, at 11:59pm. If you have a valid IKON pass you don't need to purchase racer tickets.

Tickets can be printed out in the Kiosk in front of ticket office. Bib pickup by Team Coach at 7:30am morning of race at the Alpine Race Shack. Athletes will use their bib for each race.
